He joined our parish as a young adult and served as our Youth Minister in 2012-13. Priest FAQ

When it's said that there are two kinds of Catholic priests, it is in reference to diocesan priests and non-diocesan priests. They differ in the authority that they are called to obey and in the vows that they make.

The diocesan priest (such as Fr. Adam and I) is ordained for a particular geographical area is under the supervision of the diocesan bishop (currently Archbishop Allen Vigneron). To the Bishop, he makes the promises of obedience and celibacy. He does not make a vow of poverty, which means that he can own property or be involved in operating a business, over and above the ministry capacity in which he is called to serve. Usually these priests will only minister in their diocese.

Non-diocesan priests belong to a religious order such as the Franciscans, Jesuits, Dominicans, Crosiers, Redemptorists, etc. They make vows of obedience, chastity and poverty. They do not own personal property. Larger or more costly items they use belong to the religious community. If they receive earnings for work performed, the check goes to the religious order that provides their daily needs. They answer to their superior, not the local bishop. These priests may minister in numerous dioceses and countries during their lifetime.

You are invited to come and explore a new and vital ministry as a prayer intercessor. Intercession is best described as *"A prayer of petition which leads us to pray as Jesus did. He is the one intercessor with the Father on behalf of all men, especially sinners. He is "able for all time to save those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them. Since Abraham, intercession - asking on behalf of another has been characteristic of a heart attuned to God's mercy. In intercession, he who prays looks "not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others." (CCC 2634-35)*
